Complementary Competitions: only on 12 May 2012

Entry forms for the following competitions: Best Breeding Group, Best Couple, Best Stud Dog, Child and Dog, Junior handling, Best Head . dog and bitch, Best Ridge, Best Motion can be submitted during the Show at the Show Office.

Best Stud Dog . for a dog and at least 5 offspring, all of which must be judged at the Show. Criteria being judged: type and quality of progeny. The stud dog must be judged at the Show in any class.

Best Breeding Group . at least 3 offspring from one kennel, from two different dams or sires.

Best Couple - dog and bitch belonging to one owner.

Only dogs that have been judged at the Show may enter the competitions. Fee for any competition is EUR 10,- (CZK 100,-), payable when submitting the entry form.

All dogs must reach the required age for entering the class no later than on the day of the Show.

* The Honour Class is accessible to dogs and bitches that have been awarded the following titles: Interchampion, Champion, Club Winner, Specialty Winner or National Winner. Dogs/bitches can be presented in this Class without any claims of qualifying for CAC; dogs/bitches judged %Excellent 1+in this class cannot run for BOB.

* For the Winner and Honour Class please submit a copy of the certificate confirming the achieved titles: Interchampion, Champion, National Winner, Club Winner, Specialty Show Winner. To enter your dog to the Working Class please submit a copy of the working certificate.

Without these documents the dog/bitch will be entered into the Open Class!

Titles:

In each class (except for the Honour Class) the order of the first four dogs is stated.

CAJC . This title can be awarded to a dog and bitch that are judged as Excellent 1 in the Junior Class.

CAC - This title can be awarded to a dog and bitch that are judged as Excellent 1 in the Intermediate, Open, Working and Winner Class.

res. CAC - This title can be awarded to a dog and bitch that are judged as Excellent 2.

Best Tiny Baby 2012 of the KCHRR Club Show, Best Minor Puppy 2012 of the KCHRR Club Show, Best Puppy 2012 of the KCHRR Club Show . This title is awarded in a competition between a dog and bitch that are judged as Very Promising 1 in the Tiny Baby, Minor Puppy and Puppy Classes.

Best of Juniors 2012 of the KCHRR Club Show (BOJ) . This title is awarded in a competition between a dog and bitch that are judged as Excellent 1 in the Junior Class.

Best Dog, Best Bitch (Club Show Winner). This title is awarded in a competition between the winners of the Intermediate, Open, Working a Winner Classes that are judged as Excellent 1 and receive the title CAC, separately for dogs and bitches.

Specialty Show Winner Dog, Bitch . This title is awarded in a competition between the winners of Intermediate, Open, Working a Winner Classes that are judged as Excellent 1 and receive the title CAC, separately for dogs and bitches. It is awarded regardless of the owner's membership in KCHRR.

Best of Veterans (BOV) - This title can be awarded to a dog and bitch that are judged as Excellent 1 in the Veteran Class.

Best Of Breed (BOB) . This title is given to a dog or bitch chosen in the competition between dogs and bitches who are awarded BOJ, Club Show Winner Dog and Bitch (Best Dog, Best Bitch) and BOV.

There is no claim to any of these titles Ë judges have the right not to award any of the titles!

Veterinary regulations:

Dogs must be clinically healthy.

Dogs do not need a clinical health examination record.

During the reception of dogs a pet passport will be required showing an official proof of dog's immunity against the rabies, canine distemper, parvovirus infection and leptospirosis. Dogs do not need any further clinical health examination record.

Dogs from EU member states and third countries must have a valid pet passport and they must meet conditions stipulated by the European Parliament and Council Regulation No. 998/2003 of 26 May 2003.

Documents required for the Shows:

A show entry certificate, a copy of both sides of the pedigree certificate, a proof of entry fee payment, and a pet passport with valid vaccination.

General Conditions:

A copy of the pedigree certificate, a proof of exhibition fee payment, a performance certificate copy (for the Working Class) and a copy of the championship certificate (for the Winner and Honour Classes) must be attached to the Entry Form. Without such certificates the dog/bitch will be entered into the Open Class. The copies will not be returned.

The Entry Form will not be accepted without a proof of payment.

The postal date on envelopes with Entry Forms determines whether the first or second deadline shall apply. Entry Forms sent after the expiry of the 2nd deadline may be accepted only after a prior consent of the Show Committee.

A dog can only enter one class. Transferring dogs to a different class after the 2nd deadline is not possible. The acceptance of the dog to the Show will be confirmed in writing or via e-mail at least 7 days before the Show by a certificate of entry.

Neither the Show Committee nor KCHRR shall take responsibility for any damage caused by a dog or an exhibitor at the venue area, including the accommodation area. The dog owner or an exhibitor shall be responsible for such a damage. Neither the Show Committee nor KCHRR shall take responsibility for a loss or death of any dog. Dogs must not run loose. Biting dogs have to wear muzzles. A failure to take part in the Show shall not constitute a right to have the exhibition fee returned. An exhibitor agrees with publishing his/her address in the catalogue.

The organiser reserves the right to change and/or add judges.

Objections:

Objections against judges' decisions are inadmissible. Objections can be raised only due to formal reasons for breaching the Show Regulations and/or Schedule. An objection must be submitted together with a principal of CZK 500 during the Show. Unless the objection is found justified the principal will be forfeited for the benefit of the show organizer.
